## NOTIFICATION

### *Addendum*

The following communication, received on 9 October 2014, is being circulated at the request of the Delegation of the Separate Customs Territory of Taiwan, Penghu, Kinmen and Matsu.

Amendment of the "Quarantine Requirements for the Importation of Plants or Plant Products" and "Quarantine Requirements for the Importation of Lily Flower Bulbs from Chile"

The Separate Customs Territory of Taiwan, Penghu, Kinmen and Matsu proposed the amendment of the "Quarantine Requirements for the Importation of Plants or Plant Products" and "Quarantine Requirements for the Importation of Lily Flower Bulbs from Chile" on 16 September 2014 (G/SPS/N/TPKM/324). The growers that intend to export lily bulbs to the Separate Customs Territory of Taiwan, Penghu, Kinmen and Matsu shall register to the Servicio Agrícola y Ganadero (SAG). The field inspections for virus symptoms shall be conducted twice and confirmed that the field is fully compliant with the requirements. In addition, the export and import inspection and the measures in case of non-compliance, suspension and reinstatement of the system are listed in these quarantine requirements. The amendment and the requirements were promulgated and entered into force on 19 September 2014.
