The 6. revision regulates the local and central competent authorities on pest surveillance and pest control, and regulates the central competent authority to promulgate the regulated articles which are subject to plant quarantine and their import requirements, facilitating plant guarantine measures for the settlement of Free Trade Zones and paperless customs clearance. The main purpose of this amendment is to adjust the hierarchy of the law for some phytosanitary requirements in order to improve the regulatory framework of plant protection and quarantine. 7.
