6.	Description of content: The draft regulates the quarantine requirements for the importation of Turkey's fresh cherries. Fresh cherries from Turkey shall be subject to a system approach including registration of supplying orchards and packinghouses, preselection procedures and export inspection. The fresh cherries should also have to be imported in commercial consignments, treated with cold treatment prior to export, and accompanied by a phytosanitary certificate issued by the national plant protection organization of Turkey declaring that the regulated measures addressed in this draft quarantine requirements are met.
